Colossians 1:6	All over the world this gospel is bearing fruit and growing, just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and understood God's grace in all its truth.
1 Corinthians 15:10	But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than them all – yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me.
